He works as assistant professor at the Faculty of Archaeology of Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań. He is a member of the Polish Historical Association and the Polish-Czech Scientific Society. He has taken part in over a dozen archaeological excavations in Poland and abroad as well as several research projects. He has authored nearly eighty academic publications including three monographs (Sieć grodowa na Kujawach oraz jej funkcje od połowy X do końca XIII wieku, Poznań 2016; Wojenny Poznań. Fortyfikacje i walki o miasto do XVIII wieku [together with Z. Pliarczyk and K. Kościelniak], Poznań 2017; Cuiavia Christiana. U progu chrześcijaństwa i Kościoła na Kujawach w X-XII wieku, Poznań 2019). He has been an active participant of several dozen conferences in Poland and abroad. At present, Marcin Danielewski is in charge of an interdisciplinary academic project "The stronghold in Grzybowo and its settlement supply base in the context of in-depth interdisciplinary research" (research project number UMO-2017/25/B/HS3/00016), financed by the National Science Centre in Poland. His research interests revolve around strongholds, the economy in the Piast dynasty dominion, the Polish-Russian relations in the early Middle Ages, stronghold settlement in Kuyavia and historical re-enactment.


